
Re: A Commendation for your tremendous work in recruiting Election Volunteers



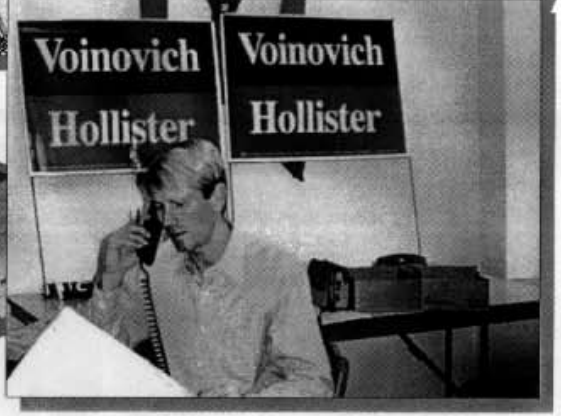
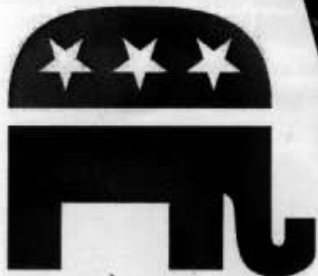
